Purpose of Employee Handbook







Policies that do not comply with legal updates







• Excluding policies **REQUIRED** by law





- Providing benefit or right NOT REQUIRED by law
 - Consider business decision: Do these policies create a competitive advantage in industry?





 Policies infringing on protected concerted activities of employees





Reducing Potential Liability

- Revise policies to comply with legal updates
- Include policies required by law
- Determine business strategy for including optional policies

Reducing Potential Liability

- At-will Employment
- Disclaimers
- Voluntary Resignation (no-call no show; 3 days)
- No Authority to Act on Behalf of Company



Reducing Potential Liability

- Complaint Procedure
- Prohibition Against Retaliation
