 For Guardianship or Conservatorship in the State of Michigan, a Court Petition is filed.



The standard is whether, due to physical or mental conditions, a person is unable to manage their medical issues, care, assets or business affairs.



A Judge determines if such a condition exists and thereafter supervises, in various ways, all the activities of the person they appoint a Fiduciary.








- Powers of Attorney operate outside of Court supervision.
- There are varying standards in which a Power of Attorney can be used.



 Some POA'S are effective immediately upon their signing.






Some require various written medical support to become effective (i.e. Springing).

 They also report to the heirs at law as it relates solely to any assets remaining in the deceased's sole name at the time of death.



TRUSTEES





TRUSTEES

- Can act either at the time of death
- Or when incapacity occurs as previously defined in the previously signed Trust agreement



LEGAL LANDMINES

- Sometimes your former client, who is still alive, contacts you after you know about a Probate or Power of Attorney already in play.
- Sometimes, either pre- or post-death heirs/beneficiaries contact you about your client's affairs.



LEGAL LANDMINES

- Occasionally, a conflict of interest may arise as to whom you owe a loyalty to.
- Sometimes a Fiduciary who is your client acts in a way that could be construed as a breach of Fiduciary duty and puts you, as their CPA, in harm's way.



LEGAL LANDMINES

As always, you should consider a CYA approach to any family disharmony, so you don't get caught up in the legal fracas.
